Spring Gowning and Gloving

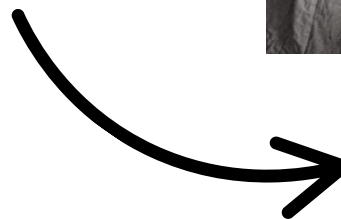
