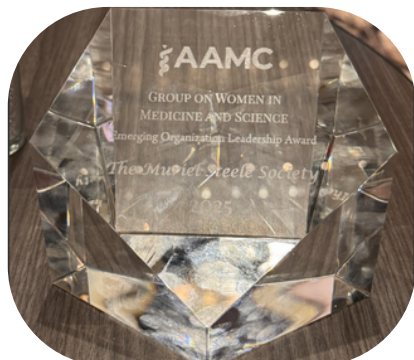

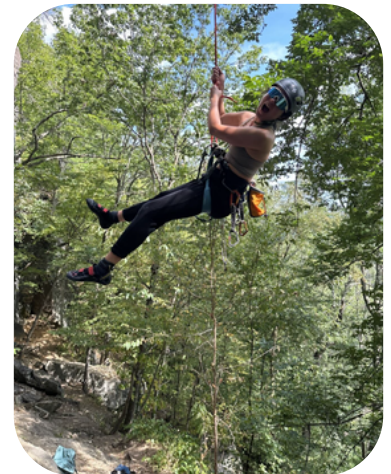


Clara Starkweather, MD, PhD

Dr. Clara Starkweather is a PGY-6 Neurosurgery Resident at UCSF. She earned her MD and PhD from Harvard Medical School. Her work focuses on understanding the brain signaling that drives decision making and advancing targeted neuromodulation approaches for psychiatric disorders.

Below is an excerpt from her spotlight, conducted by medical student Parisa Jahangirizadeh that is **coming soon to the MSS website!**

"...It was an emotional moment for the patient. Seeing that kind of impact was very addictive to me. It's just so cool that the work we do has an immediate impact. That very short time course of - we showed up today, and we did our best to fix this problem, and sometimes it is fixed - that's magical to me."



"I feel a sense of wonder always, even in the simplest cases...What we operate on is personal; it's what makes you a person."
